# PATHS® Plus Information Sheet for Parents/Carers

#### 1. What is PATHS® Plus?

Barnardo's, the Children's Charity, is pleased to inform you that they will be delivering the PATHS® Plus Programme in your child's school. The PATHS® Plus Programme involves lots of fun activities both in class, and in small Friendship Group sessions dealing with important issues such as Feelings, Behaviours, Solving Problems, Making and Keeping Friends, and Self-Esteem. This programme is funded by the Big Lottery.

## 2. PATHS® Curriculum and Friendship Group:

As part of the 'PATHS® Plus Programme', <u>all</u> children will receive weekly lessons in class using the PATHS® Curriculum. The PATHS® Curriculum is a US evidence-based programme, and has been adapted for a UK audience by Barnardo's NI.

In addition to the whole-class PATHS® programme, Barnardo's will be delivering weekly Friendship Group sessions that give children the opportunity to practice skills learnt during PATHS® lessons in a small group-based format. The groups meet once a week for 45 minutes and your child may occasionally be involved in these group activities. Some children will be chosen by their class teacher to be the "Friendship Group Ambassador". These children will attend **every** session.

If you would prefer your child to **not** take part in Friendship Group, please tick the relevant box on the Non-Consent Form.

### 3. Photographs/Videos:

From time-to-time Barnardo's would like to take some photos/videos of a 'PATHS® Plus' session in action. The photographs will be stored securely by Barnardo's and may be used to promote the programme (and your child's school) in the following ways:
